- ✓ Food banks, Family Support Centers, WIC offices and other locations approved on a case by case basis. Trip requests to destinations outside the area will be transported to the nearest bus stop connection.
- ✓ Service from Buckley to Plateau Outreach Ministries in Enumclaw is also available

#### How many rides can I have?

- ✓ 3 round-trip rides per month
