

Senior Year Calendar

Apply to colleges and make decisions. Finish high school strong.

September

- Request brochures and applications from your prospective schools – watch for specific deadlines.
- Request letters of recommendation.
- Inquire if your prospective schools offer early admissions.
- Research and review scholarship bulletin and financial aid options through the guidance center.
- Schedule campus visit.
- Register for ACT or SAT if you have not already done so.

October

- Conference with career counselor about your future plans.
- Draft applications essay with your English teacher.
- Complete and submit your application if you are applying on an “early decision” basis.
- Finalize college bound athletic form (NCAA).
- Military – see recruiter for options.
- Check technical program availability – waiting lists.
- Attend Jr./Sr. Parent Night.
- Attend college fair.
- Register for ACT or SAT if you have not already done so.

November

- Check deadlines and entrance requirements for all colleges that you are considering.
- Military – register for ASVAB test.
- Continue researching and applying for scholarships.
- Continue researching and discussing financial aid needs.
- Register for ACT or SAT if you have not already done so.

December

- Apply to selected colleges. Keep copies of application and other paperwork in your file folder.
- Keep checking the scholarship bulletin and on the internet at www.fastweb.com or www.whiteriver.wednet.edu.
- Attend Financial Aid Night and collect financial records for Free Application for Federal Student AID (FAFSA). Forms are due as soon as possible after January 1st.
- Registration deadline for dual credit.

Senior Year Calendar Cont'd

January

- Request transcript to be sent of your first semester grades to the colleges to which you applied.
- Complete FAFSA. www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Send applications to prospective schools.
- Check for specific scholarships and financial aid forms with colleges you plan to attend.
- Continue researching and applying for scholarships through the internet and the scholarship bulletin through the guidance center.
- Keep working within classes. Grades and courses continue to impact.

February

- Research possible sources of financial aid, scholarships on bulletin. www.fastweb.com & www.whiteriver.wednet.edu.
- Verify that the information on your SAR (Student Aid Report from FAFSA) is correct.

March

- Stay focused and keep studying.

April

- Make your final decision on which school you want to attend and send in your deposit.
- Continue your research for scholarships through the internet at www.fastweb.com and scholarship bulletin.

May

- Notify colleges to which you applied but do not plan to attend.
- Complete housing and financial aid forms.
- Look for summer job opportunities.
- AP Testing.
- Deadline for dual credit.

June

- Have your high school send your final transcript to your college of choice.
- Review payment dates for housing tuition and other expenses.
- Hornet Honors Evening.
- Graduation.
