What you should expect:

Intakes are offered on a first come, first serve basis as follows

- Meet with an admissions specialist to complete initial paperwork
- Assessment with a clinical intake worker to determine eligibility
- If eligible, you receive a call to schedule within 48 hours
- Entire intake process can take approximately 2 hours
